PILOT PHASE 1: EXPERIMENTATION OF THE BBU METHODOLOGY WITH THE EDUCATORS

Prior to the BBU methodology training, motivated and willing educators signed up via a registration form. Each partner had the objective of training 10 educators, making a total of 50 educators trained in the BBU methodology.

The training lasted two days and included both theory and practice. At the end of their training, the educators completed an evaluation questionnaire and then exchanged and discussed the methodology, the aim being to collect all feedback, comments and opinions that could help improve the methodological content. The feedback was positive and rich.

We are now entering pilot phase 2, where educators trained in the BBU methodology will test the activities on their own audiences.

On 25 and 26 of August, the consortium met in Bratislava, Slovakia.


This TPM was an opportunity for the partners to meet physically for the first time, with the exception of Eurocrea Merchant, which was unable to travel and participating in the TPM remotely.

Finally, the consortium discussed the communication and dissemination of the project.
